Composite Description

The composite represents the total returns of all fully discretionary portfolios with a US Equity Concentrated investment mandate. The Lazard US Equity Concentrated strategy is a concentrated, all cap strategy designed to leverage the best ideas of the US Equity team. The strategy invests in financially productive companies across the market capitalization spectrum (generally greater than \$350 million), employing intensive fundamental analysis and accounting validation to identify investment opportunities. Effective April 2024, due to the departure of the current lead portfolio manager, a new individual has assumed the role of lead portfolio manager.

Calculation of Performance Returns

The composite returns presented represent past performance and is not a reliable indicator of future results, which may vary. Lazard’s US Equity Concentrated Composite product invests in a relatively small number of securities. Should any individual security held in this portfolio decline in value or underperform relative to the market, it may have a greater impact on the account’s performance than if the account held a larger number of securities. An account invested using this strategy may experience more volatility.

Fee Schedule

Lazard’s standard fee schedule for US Equity Concentrated accounts is 0.75%. The management fee schedule and total expense ratio for the collective trust is 0.70% and 0.80%, respectively. Unless otherwise noted, actual account fees, inclusive of performance-based fees and VAT (if applicable) are used in the construction of composite net of fee performance. For non-fee paying portfolios and sleeves of funds, net of fee performance has been calculated using the strategy’s standard fee schedule.

Benchmark Information

The S&P 500 Index is an index of 500 industrial, utility, transportation and financial companies of the US markets (mostly NYSE issues). It is a capitalization-weighted index calculated on a total return basis with dividends reinvested.
