Composite Description

The composite returns represent the total returns of all fully discretionary institutional portfolios with an Emerging Markets Discounted Assets investment mandate and a minimum of \$5 million in assets under management. Lazard's Emerging Markets Discounted Assets strategy seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing in companies trading at a discount to their estimated net asset value. These include closed-end funds, investment trusts, holding companies, and special situations companies, which invest in global companies with strong, sustainable financial productivity at attractive valuations. The strategy utilizes a corporate governance approach to seek to reduce or eliminate these discounts.

Calculation of Performance Returns

The composite and benchmark returns are reported net of foreign withholding taxes on dividends, interest and capital gains. Prior to 2016, gross returns are net of operational expenses. The composite returns presented represent past performance and is not a reliable indicator of future results, which may vary.

Fee Schedule

Lazard's standard fee schedule for Emerging Markets Discounted Assets accounts is 1.0% on the first \$100 million of assets and 0.75% on the balance. (This fee schedule may be presented in non-U.S. local currency equivalents based on prevailing exchange rates.) The management fee schedule and total expense ratio for the pooled fund is 1.00% and 1.12%, respectively. Unless otherwise noted, actual account fees, inclusive of performance-based fees and VAT (if applicable) are used in the construction of composite net of fee performance. For non-fee paying portfolios and sleeves of funds, net of fee performance has been calculated using the strategy's standard fee schedule.

Benchmark Information

Due to client demand as well as better comparability with our peers, we have changed the composite benchmark from the IFC Global Regional Composite Index to a blended index consisting of the IFC Global Regional Composite Index and the MSCI Emerging Markets Index as of December 2006. The new custom benchmark consists of the IFC Global Regional Composite index through December 31, 1995, followed by the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (GDR) through December 31, 1998, then by the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (NDR) from January 1, 1999, to the present. The IFC Composite Index is an emerging market index covering 27 developing nations and containing over 1,650 stocks. The MSCI Emerging Markets Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization index calculated gross of foreign withholding taxes through December 31, 1998, and total return net of foreign withholding taxes thereafter, that is designed to measure equity market performance in the global emerging
