

Lazard European Convertibles Defensive

Composite Description

The composite returns represent the total returns of all fully discretionary portfolios with a European Convertibles Defensive mandate with a minimum market value of €5,000,000. The strategy seeks to outperform the Euro Overnight Index Average (EONIA) annually over a three-year period. The strategy can invest from 25% to 100% of its net assets in both euro-denominated convertible bonds issued in Europe and in non-convertible bonds. The strategy can invest up to 75% in cash and money market instruments if necessary. The investment team employs a fundamental, bottom-up approach that utilizes rigorous qualitative and quantitative analysis to drive security selection, complemented by a top-down process that guides tactical positioning. Total exposure to equities will be maintained at a level below 40% of the total assets and interest rate risk will be managed dynamically in order to optimize the strategy's performance over the medium term. The investment team may, and has in the past, use futures, swaps, and options to hedge the strategy and/or adjust the strategy's exposure to equity and interest rate risk. Performance data prior to December 31, 2017 represents the strategy managed by the Convertibles team at a prior firm and comprise substantially of all the investment decision makers of that team. The Convertibles team employs a substantially similar investment strategy to manage this European Convertibles Defensive strategy as it did at its prior firm.

Calculation of Performance Returns

The composite returns are reported net of foreign withholding taxes on dividends, interest and capital gains. The composite returns presented represent past performance and is not a reliable indicator of future results, which may vary.

Fee Schedule

Lazard's standard fee schedule for the European Convertibles Defensive strategy accounts is 0.60% per annum on the first \$50 million, 0.55% on the next \$100 million, 0.50% on the next \$100 million and 0.45% on the balance. (This fee schedule may be presented in non-U.S. local currency equivalents based on prevailing exchange rates.) Unless otherwise noted, actual account fees, inclusive of performance-based fees and VAT (if applicable) are used in the construction of composite net of fee performance. For non-fee paying portfolios and sleeves of funds, net of fee performance has been calculated using the strategy's standard fee schedule. Fund performance in this composite is net of all fees.

Benchmark Information

The benchmark is the Euro Short-Term Rate (ESTR) + 2.5% annualized hurdle, effective January 1, 2022. The ESTR is an interest rate benchmark that reflects the overnight borrowing costs of banks within the eurozone. Prior to that, the benchmark was the European Overnight Index Average + 2.5% annualized hurdle. This is the average interest rate at which a selection of European banks lend one another funds whereby the loans have a maturity date of one day.
